The Barber Tract Neighborhood Association (BTNA) was originally formed by neighbors in 1989 and is now a nonprofit organization. BTNA's main objectives include fostering friendships within our community and hosting social events and gatherings throughout the year, such as the annual Fourth of July block party and holiday events.

Member dues are only \$50 per person per calendar year, and help support things like BTNA's social events, website, and newsletters. Any adult who lives in the Barber Tract neighborhood can become a member, and we invite all adults in the household to join as members.

The Barber Tract neighborhood is currently defined as the residential area in La Jolla, extending east from the Pacific Ocean to the west side of La Jolla Boulevard, and south from Pearl Street to the south side of Westbourne Street. While properties such as White Sands La Jolla, the League House, and the Darlington House are not formally included in the area under our existing bylaws, their residents remain valued friends and neighbors of the Barber Tract Neighborhood Association.
